

Naperville Little League Majors Field Procedures

Please take care of our fields. Rake and fill and pound the mound, rake and fill sliding areas and rake, fill and pound batter boxes after the last game and between games-time permitting. Clean up after your team, empty the garbage cans and pick-up bottles and trash. All field lights will come on or off automatically. If your game ends early, is cancelled or you need more time, please call your league director of the field you are playing at to turn on or off the lights.

Visiting team is responsible for setting up the field and home team is responsible for shutting down the field. Both teams should help get the field ready after severe weather.

Home team is responsible for running the score booth, an adult must always be present.

Visiting team occupies the first base dugout and the home team occupies the third base dugout.

No music is to be played at any field after 10:00pm.

Knoch 5:

Lockbox is on the fence near the first base dugout. The key opens both lower doors and the score booth at the top of the stairs. Bases are in the south storage room with striper, rakes, supplies and umpire gear. All switches should be turned off for scoreboard and PA system at the end of the night. Maximum lights on is 10:30pm.

Nike 1 and Nike 3:

Lockbox is on the brown electrical transformer near the building. The key opens the storage room door (northwest side) and the announcer's booth (entrance near the electrical box). Umpire gear and bases are in the field boxes next to first base dug-outs. Maximum lights on is 10:30pm.

The Beach:

Lockbox is on the fence near the first base dugout. Field striper, supplies, umpire gear, etc. are in the storage room (first base side). Maximum lights on is 10:15pm.

Dupage 5

Lockbox is located on the fence behind the building. The key opens the announcer's booth and the storage area (our storage door is the farthest (north) double door. The bases and umpire gear are in the field box.
